Opened in 1871, the Royal Albert Hall is one of London's most iconic music venues and tourist attractions.



Over the past 147 years, it has hosted over 380,000 mesmerising performances; from Wagner to Sinatra, the Beatles to Beyoncé, and Muhammad Ali to Adele, and is also home to the celebrated BBC Proms.



The Grand Tour offers a fascinating journey into the Hall's rich history, astonishing architecture and legendary performances. Highlights include the Queen's Box, the Royal Retiring Room, the main auditorium and the Gallery.

### Accessibility:

All tour routes cover a moderate distance and can involve stairs. However, lifts are available and all tour routes are accessible to guests who use wheelchairs.

### Timetable:

The 702 bus from Reading via Legoland stops at a number of places in Slough and along the London Road; bus pass is accepted. It takes about an hour to reach Kensington and stops right outside the Albert Hall. Departures from Wellington Street at 10:20 and 11:10
